

OMT Essential Agreement

In Prep MT we have been working together and thinking about how we can make our classroom a happy and safe place to learn. In our classroom we agree to be:

Respectful

- We will use our manners.
- We will use whole body listening.
- We will look after our books, toys and classroom equipment.
- We will keep our hands and feet to ourselves.

Caring

- We will help each other if we are hurt or sad.
- We will share with each other.
- We will be nice and caring.



Cooperation

- We will be nice and share our things.
- We will take turns when playing games.
- We will work in teams.
- We will help each other.



Positive Consequences

In Prep MT, we have 10 happy steps that we follow. We will move happy steps when we show the right attitudes, behaviours and choices. Once we have moved to the tenth happy step we can choose a reward from our class list.

If I make the right choice I may:

- Go on the iPad and read, write and draw or go on different Apps
- Play Connect Four or Snakes and Ladders
- Play with Mrs Trajkovski's toys
- Draw on the mini whiteboards/paper
- Colour in the colouring books
- Reading in the classroom library
- Using the play dough to make things
- Playing in the kitchen
- Playing with the hot wheel cars.
- Playing with the blocks.
- To use paper to make things
- Dress ups
- If I'm on green at the end of the day, I move happy steps



Negative Consequences

If I make the wrong choice I will:

1. Get a verbal warning from Mrs Trajkovski.
2. Mrs Trajkovski will remind us of Our Essential Agreement.
3. My Name tag will be removed from the green traffic light to the yellow traffic light and I will be moved away from my classmates. 1 minute at next break to discuss behaviour/rule not followed.
4. If I continue to make wrong choices my name will be placed on the red traffic light. I will get sent to another room for 5 minutes.
5. Spend time at recess/lunch discussing my behaviour with the teacher.
(A note may go home)
6. Have my parents contacted to organise a meeting with the Mrs Trajkovski and/or Mr Moodley.
