Negative Consequences : When we break the Essential Agreement we will

- \* Fine (earn & learn style) individual students or deduct class points
- \* Spend a lunch detention writing out Essential Agreement and/or Respect sheet
- \* Discuss behavioural issues with Mrs Lockwood
- \* Parents will be notified
- \* A meeting with parents and Mrs Lockwood will take place and a behaviour plan created.
