## Prep KS – Term 3 Show and Tell

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Below is a timetable for the weekly topics for show and tell. Every week the children will have a different focus for their show and tell and are expected to participate in order to further develop their communication skills. Please see the table below to find out what the topic is for each week and find attached the day of the week your child will be presenting. Please keep it mind that if your child is absent or forgets that there will not be a make up day, they can join in next week on the new topic.

<b>Week 1</b> <b>July 17-21</b>	<b><u>Holiday Recount</u></b> What fun things did you get up to on the school holidays? Bring in some pictures, a drawing, brochures of what you and your family did together!
<b>Week 2</b> <b>July 24-28</b>	<b><u>Free Choice</u></b> Students can bring in 1 item of their choice that they would like to share with the class
<b>Week 3</b> <b>July 31-August 4</b>	<b><u>Inquiry Artefact</u></b> Our 4 <sup>th</sup> inquiry's Central Idea is 'Living things depend on each other and their environment.' We will be looking into life cycles of insects, amphibians, and plants. Bringing 1 artefact that relates to this subject, might be a book, garden themed, life cycle themed, etc.
<b>Week 4</b> <b>August 7-11</b>	<b><u>If I could have any pet I would have?</u></b> You have been given the choice to pick any pet in the world! What kind of pet would you choose? Draw a detailed picture of you and your pet and what adventures you might have together?
<b>Week 5</b> <b>August 14-18</b>	<b><u>Free Choice</u></b> Students can bring in 1 item of their choice that they would like to share with the class.
<b>Week 6</b> <b>August 21-25</b>	<b><u>Joke Week</u></b> Tell the class your favourite joke. Come prepared with how to deliver your joke and the punch line!
<b>Week 7</b> <b>August 28- Sept. 1</b>	<b><u>Free Choice</u></b> Students can bring in 1 item of their choice that they would like to share with the class.
<b>Week 8</b> <b>Sept. 4-8</b>	<b><u>Inquiry Artefact</u></b> Our 5 <sup>th</sup> Inquiry's central idea looks into 'Animals are endangered due to human actions.' Preps are encouraged to look into animals all around the world that are endangered or extinct and tell the class why. They might bring in pictures, books, or a stuff toy to talk to the class.
<b>Week 9</b> <b>Sept. 11-15</b>	<b><u>Free Choice</u></b> Students can bring in 1 item of their choice that they would like to share with the class.
<b>Week 10</b> <b>Sept. 18-22</b>	<b><u>Holidays are coming</u></b> What would you like to do? Predict one activity you might do. Will you visit your cousins, play in the yard, go for a bike ride or maybe play on the iPad. Draw us a detailed pictured and write a sentence (parents may help scribe for your child).
